





10 Night Rider and Blue Demon Tube Slides

You must be 47 inches or 119 centimeters tall to go down these slides. You and your tube partner, must weigh less than 400 lbs to ride these slides. Complimentary pink tubes are provided for these slides or rent a single clear tube, (on a firstcome, first-served basis).

BODY SLIDES

Corkscrew and Kamikaze Body Slides

You must be 42 inches or 107 centimeters tall to go on these slides. You must weigh less than 300 lbs to ride these slides.

Pack the right bathing suit!

Proper bathing attire is required on all attractions at Wild Waterworks (no street clothes in the water).



- 1. All guests, regardless of age, must wear a proper bathing suit.
- 2. Undergarments/boxer shorts are not allowed for health reasons.
- Unlined gym shorts (basketball type shorts), cargo shorts, street pants of any kind, jean shorts, cut-off shorts are not proper bathing suits.
- 3. Swimwear with metal rivets, buttons, buckles, snaps, zippers, or sharp objects will not be permitted on the slides as it damages the rides and could potentially injure riders.
- Guests who are not toilet trained, or are incontinent, must wear a swim-rated diaper, in and on, all water park attractions.



Bring in your picnics and coolers... Please do not pack glass, alcohol, knives or barbeques.

We welcome our guests to bring in outside food, coolers and lawn chairs. For safety reasons, Wild Waterworks does not allow glass, alcohol, knives or barbeques, in the water park.




Good things to know ahead of time!

- No animals of any kind are allowed in the water park. (Except for legally-defined service animals, with proper verification. Service animals are prohibited, in or on, all attractions).
- Use your waterwings in Little Squirt Works! You may use non-approved floatation devices in Little Squirt Works only.
- Bring your own government approved lifejackets/PFDs. They may worn in the Wave Pool and the Eazy River.
- Balls, frisbees, water toys, etc. are not allowed in the water park.

Lifejacket rules are in effect



Regulations, affecting public pools, have been put into place by the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.

Wild Waterworks must follow the regulation.

Wild Waterworks requires anyone 10 years of age, and under, to wear a government approved lifejacket/PFD in the Wave Pool and the Eazy River.

Wild Waterworks will have lifejackets/PFDs available on a first-come, first-served basis, free of charge, for guests' use. They are on racks, located near the Wave Pool and Eazy River. Staff are available to assist with sizing and answer questions.

Wild Waterworks welcomes guests to bring their own government approved lifejacket/PFD for use in the Wave Pool and Eazy River.

Lifejackets/PFDs must be approved by: Transport Canada, Oceans and Fisheries Canada. Canadian Coast Guard and USA Coast Guard Type 1, 2 or III.

For supervision of those 10 years of age and under, the guardian or designated person, 16 years of age or older, must be within arm's reach, at all times, while in the water, and the following ratios must be adhered to:

Children under age 6: Two children with a lifejacket/PFD to one guardian (2:1) 16 years of age or older.

Children aged 6 to 10: Eight children with a lifejacket/PFD to one
