Be water aware this summer... learn the important basics of water safety.

Water safety sessions run from 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. followed by water play from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Weekdays, June 11-15, June 18-22 and June 25-26, 2018. No Waves days are June 13,14, 15, 20,21,22 and 26, 2018.

Cost per session: \$9.65 per student.

Tube and lifejacket rentals available \$3. each. Teachers and supervisors admitted free, (within accepted ratios).

Additional supervisory support is \$15. per person.

Instruction by Certified Water Safety Instructors with a safe student/instructor ratio.
